

First Christian Church/Bristol Academy Student Network Use Agreement

I agree to the following:

1. I understand that use of the First Christian Church/Bristol Academy network is a cooperative effort, and I will make every attempt to be prudent and considerate in my use of the network.
2. I will not share the password to the network with any other individual.
3. I will use the First Christian Church/Bristol Academy network only for school-related use. I will not use the network for personal use - to include downloading or playing games, songs or videos.
4. I agree to use my laptop/device only in study hall and will keep my screen viewable from the study hall entrance or by the study hall monitor if applicable.
5. I will confine the use of the network to myself and will not allow anyone else to use my laptop/device.
6. I will not willfully destroy, damage, tamper, alter, steal, misappropriate or use without permission any network equipment, system, program or file of First Christian Church.
7. I understand that First Christian Church/Bristol Academy is not responsible for any loss of data.
8. I understand and agree that each time I access the First Christian Church/Bristol Academy network I am bound by these terms of this agreement, along with any changes or additions to this agreement, and the terms of all the Bristol Academy policies that are in effect at the time I access the system.
9. I understand that violations of this agreement may result in the revoking of all my network access privileges.

The misuse, disruption, or destruction of computer and networks is prohibited. Examples of this type of behavior include, but are not limited to:

- Using computers or networks in a fashion that causes harassment, abuse, or intimidation of another person
- Using computers or networks to access pornography or other immoral materials
- Damaging or stealing church-owned equipment or software
- Sending or printing patently offensive mail, documents, or images
- Maliciously causing computer system slowdowns or rendering systems inoperable and denying access to users
- Gaining or attempting to gain access to accounts without proper authorization
- Putting viruses or worms into a computer system
- Sending or receiving large files/data streams on a sustained and frequent basis that negatively impacts the network
